**2010 YOUNG ARTIST COMPETITION**  
**Competition Regulations**

The Austin Flute Club is pleased to announce the Twenty-second Annual Young Artist Competition, which seeks to recognize outstanding young flute and piccolo players.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

There are three divisions: the *Junior Flute Division (grades 8-9)*, the *Senior Flute Division (grades 10-12)*, and the *Piccolo Division (grades 10-12)*. The contestant may not be a former first place winner in the same division.

The contestant's flute teacher must be a member of the *Austin Flute Club*. Yearly teacher membership dues are \$25.00. If the teacher has not already paid 2009-10 dues, payment must be submitted with the student's Young Artist Competition Application. Application will be processed only after the teacher's membership dues are current with The Austin Flute Club.

**AWARDS:**

Prizes are as follows:

- ♪ *Senior Flute Division* – \$300 (1<sup>st</sup>), \$200 (2<sup>nd</sup>), and \$100 (3<sup>rd</sup>)
- ♪ *Junior Flute Division* – \$150 (1<sup>st</sup>), \$100 (2<sup>nd</sup>), and \$50 (3<sup>rd</sup>)
- ♪ *Piccolo Division* – \$300 (1<sup>st</sup>) and \$200 (2<sup>nd</sup>). \*\*\* 2<sup>nd</sup> place prize is contingent on the number of applicants.

The winners will be presented in a joint recital on **Sunday, March 28th, 2010 at 2:30 p.m.** Prizes will be awarded at that time.

**REPERTOIRE:**

- ♪ *Junior Flute Division* contestants will perform a solo of their choice as well as the required piece: I. Moderato, and II. Allegro, from Hugo Alfvén's *Little Suite for Solo Flute*, available through the Young Artist Competition Committee.
- ♪ *Senior Flute Division* contestants will perform a solo of their choice as well as the required piece: I. Questioning, (mm. 1 - 21) and II. Jaunty, (mm. 1 - 66) from John La Montaine's *Sonata for Flute Solo*, Broude Brothers edition. *The chosen solo must be memorized.*
- ♪ *Piccolo Division* contestants will perform a solo of their choice as well as the required piece: I. Very Freely, from Martin Amlin's *Ephemeropterae for Solo Piccolo*, Theodore Presser edition.

\*\*\* Encouraged in all divisions, *Memorization of chosen solo is mandatory only for Senior Flute Division Entrants.*

**COMPETITION:**

The competition will be held on **Sunday, March 7th**, beginning at **2:00 p.m.** at the University of Texas Music Building (MRH), located at the corner of 25<sup>th</sup> and Robert Dedman Drive in Austin, Texas. You will be notified of your playing time in advance.

- ♪ Competition will be limited to 10 minutes total for each entrant, including setup, (i.e. tuning, time between pieces, etc.). Except for the required piece, works should be cut, if necessary, to comply with the audition time limit. If the contestant begins to go over the time limit, he/she will be stopped by the timekeeper. The required selection will be performed first.
- ♪ Three (3) copies of the selected music must be provided for the judges. Do not write your name on the copies. Copies will not be returned. Measures must be numbered on all copies of the music. Contestants do not need to provide copies of the required selection.
- ♪ The entrant must provide his or her own pianist, if applicable, for the audition. Competition winners must provide their own pianists for all applicable solos in the winners' recital. All accompanied pieces **MUST** be performed with piano.
- ♪ In the event of a tie, contestants must be present and prepared to replay the required piece for the judges.

**STANDARDS:**

All contestants will be judged on their overall performance, which includes musicality, tone, technical proficiency, and stage presence. The decision of the judges is final. The judges reserve the right to withhold any or all prizes.

**FEES AND APPLICATIONS:**

There is a *non-refundable* application fee of **\$35.00/\$45.00 non-members** for each entry. We are currently accepting new members. (If applying for **both the Senior Flute Division and the Piccolo Division**, this counts as **two entries** accruing a fee of **\$70.00/\$90.00**.) A check or money order is to be made payable to the "*Austin Flute Club*". Your flute instructor's 2009-10 membership dues and membership form may also be submitted at this time, if not already paid.

Application forms with fees must be postmarked **no later than February 15, 2010** and mail to: **YAC Austin Flute Club, P.O. Box 2223, Pflugerville, TX 78691**. They must be received no later than February 28<sup>th</sup> in order to be considered. Applications received after the postmark date or cutoff deadline must be accompanied by a \$15 late fee, and will be processed in the order in which they are received, based on remaining availability. Your money will be refunded if there are no available times remaining.
